MOEY/ MONROE COLLEGE (NEW YORK) SCHOLARSHIPS


The Ministry of Education and Youth in partnership with Monroe College will award scholarships to undergraduate students who have been accepted to Monroe College (New York) to pursue programmes in

- **Computer Networks and Cybersecurity**
- **Criminal Justice**

The programmes are offered online and face to face fulltime. Note students who opt to pursue the programme face to face will receive an Institutional Grant of US\$2,500 per semester from Monroe College.

ELIGIBILITY

- Scholarships are available for Jamaican nationals accepted to or registered in the undergraduate programmes noted - Returning students (second year ONLY) must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Have at least five (5) subjects in CXC/GCE examination (including Mathematics & English Language). Students with CAPE Units 1 and 2 will have an advantage
- Be no older than 35 years old.





HOW TO APPLY?

To apply for these scholarship opportunities, students **MUST** complete the official application which is available at <https://tsap.moey.gov.jm/Home/AvailableScholarships>

Supporting documents include:

- A recent passport sized photograph
- A certified copy of their birth certificate
- Proof of existing qualifications (certified copies of certificates where available)
- An acceptance letter or letter verifying that the student is registered in a programme of study
- Students who are in the second year of a four year programme applying for a scholarship should also provide a copy of a transcript
- Contact information – this should include, email addresses and telephone numbers

In addition, secondary teachers whose undergraduate qualifications do not match their teaching assignment are also eligible to apply for one of seventy (70) In-Service Scholarships which are currently available. The specialisations covered under the in-service component are: -

- Mathematics
- Geography
- Physics
- Biology
- Chemistry
- TVET Education
- English Language

Successful applicants will be bonded for a period of up to 5 years.
