



What is Academic Advisement?

A structured support system available to every student when making *important academic decisions* related to his/her courses, available options, electives, and academic progress in general.

Academic Advisors

Each Student is assigned an **Academic Advisor** (*should be confirmed after the Census date (second week) in Semester 1*). Your Advisor and Student Affairs are your first sources of support.

The Academic Advisement Unit provides assistance for students experiencing specific issues (e.g. *academic probation and restructuring of diet*).



The Academic Advisement Unit

The Academic Advisement Unit (AAU) serves as the hub of the advisement system in each College/Faculty/School and monitors the academic advisement system to assist students on **academic probation** to restructure their programme diets.

Consultations are held with students who are referred to the AAU by their Academic Advisor for **more intensive academic advisement**.




